



Code of Conduct for Club Participants

Club participants are responsible for ensuring they conform to the standards of conduct, behaviour, equality of treatment, etiquette and good manners outlined in following Code of Conduct. This has been put together in conjunctions with British Gymnastics to help ensure all of our participants and visitors have a positive experience at Majestic Gymnastics.

1. Any gymnasts that attend structured classes must be registered and insured through British gymnastics. <https://www.british-gymnastics.org/memberships>
2. Participants must learn the rules and participate within them.
3. Participants must be dressed in appropriate attire:
 - Female participants from 4-11 years old must wear a gymnastics leotard. This may be worn with shorts, joggers or leggings and a t-shirt.
 - From age 12, female participants may opt to wear a fitted sports t-shirt, and shorts, joggers or leggings.
 - Male participants must wear a fitted sports t-shirt, and shorts, joggers or leggings.
 - Socks must be removed unless you are participating in a trampoline lesson.
 - Garments with hoods, exposed zips, buttons or other attachments that may be a danger to the gymnast are not allowed in the gymnastics hall.
4. Participants must have any loose hair tied back and away from the face.
5. All jewellery must be removed.
 - Newly pierced ears may be covered with plasters or microporous tape for the first six weeks.
6. Participants must use proper and correct language at all times.
7. Participants must give the club one term notice if they wish to discontinue lessons.
 - Participants will not be refunded if they choose to leave part way through a term.
 - Fees are non-refundable – exceptional circumstances will be considered.
8. Share any concerns or complaints about any aspect of the club through the approved channels. <https://www.majesticgymnastics.co.uk/safeguarding>
9. Participants must not leave the premises without parental supervision.
 - Gymnasts must remain with a coach until dismissed.
 - Toilet facilities are located within the gymnastics hall
10. Participants must not enter the gymnastics hall without permission.
 - If you need to speak to a coach, you should inform the receptionist.
11. Respect the personal judgement/decisions of the coaches.
12. Respect the gymnastics hall and equipment.
13. Participants must not smoke, consume alcohol, take drugs of any kind, or be under the influence of any substance when participating in gymnastics at Majestic Gymnastics Academy.
14. Participants must not eat or chew gum during a gymnastics lesson.
15. Respect the rights of others and remain courteous at all times. The club will not tolerate aggressive or threatening behaviour towards any member, employee or volunteer.
16. Inform a coach of any injury or illness before the start of the lesson.



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Competitive Gymnasts

1. Publicly accept officials' judgements.
2. Discourage challenging/arguing with officials.
3. Recognise good performance, not just good results.
4. Ensure prompt arrival to training and events.
5. Ensure club attire is kept to a high standard and you arrive well presented to events.
6. Set a good example by recognising sportsmanship and applauding the performances of all competitors.
7. Uphold Majestic Gymnastics values and ethos when representing the club at any outside event.
 - Be polite and respectful
 - Be motivated and eager to learn
 - Demonstrate honesty and integrity
8. Ensure your behaviour is appropriate and aligned with the Code of Conduct when representing the club during an event.
